RULES FOR VISITORS DURING A MEETING

As a member/visitor of the Hall, there are some rules that you must follow:

- Mobile phones must be on silent
- Eating or drinking is not permitted inside the Hall
- You must cause as little disturbance as possible when entering and exiting the Hall
- You must not walk in and out of the Hall unnecessarily

It is permitted to take pictures or record with a mobile phone, however the following must be observed:

- Photography / video recording must not disturb the members and other members of the audience in the Hall

CLOSED MEETINGS

As a rule, the negotiations in Inatsisartut are public, but certain types of negotiations take place behind closed doors. This means that the public is not allowed to observe the negotiations.

At the beginning of a closed meeting, the chairperson typically announces that the meeting is now closed. Members of the public present must leave the Hall without further ado in such situations.

DISTURBANCE

The chairperson may at any time issue a warning if the chairperson finds that the behavior of the audience/press in the Hall is causing a disturbance. In such cases, the audience/press must immediately comply. In addition, the audience/press must follow any instructions from the officers in the Hall.

JACKETS AND BAGS

Jackets and bags must be placed in the lockers located on the 1st floor. When attendees are escorted to the Hall, they will also be shown to the lockers where jackets and bags must be left in the lockable lockers.
