

## **RULES FOR VISITORS DURING A MEETING**

As a member/visitor of the chamber, there are some rules that you must follow:

- Mobile phones must be on silent
- Eating or drinking is not permitted inside the chamber
- You must cause as little disturbance as possible when entering and exiting the chamber
- You must not walk in and out of the chamber unnecessarily
- Photography and video recording is not allowed.

### **CLOSED MEETINGS**

As a rule, the negotiations in Inatsisartut are public, but certain types of negotiations take place behind closed doors. This means that the public is not allowed to observe the negotiations.

At the beginning of a closed meeting, the chairperson typically announces that the meeting is now closed. Members of the public present must leave the chamber without further ado in such situations.

### **DISTURBANCE**

The chairperson may at any time issue a warning if the chairperson finds that the behaviour of the audience/press in the chamber is causing a disturbance. In such cases, the audience/press must immediately comply. In addition, the audience/press must follow any instructions from the officers in the chamber.

### **JACKETS AND BAGS**

Jackets and bags must be placed in the lockers on the 1st floor. When attendees are escorted to the chamber, they will also be shown to the lockers where jackets and bags must be left in the lockers.
